

Between-Services Treats

1. Know which months will be yours. These dates are shared at quarterly meetings and are also on the WMF website. Put these months in your calendar.
2. 2-3 weeks ahead, communicate with your group members to determine which ladies will bring which weeks.
3. Make sure you have 12+ dozen baked or purchased treats coming. An easy way to do this is to assign four ladies 3+ dozen each OR three ladies 4+ dozen each.
4. Mid-week, send a reminder to the group of ladies serving on the coming Sunday. This is a good time to remind of the expectations for serving:
 - a. Have the treats displayed by 10 AM.
 - b. Stand, serve, and greet the church family.
 - c. Begin cleanup by 10:25.
 - d. Wipe counters in the kitchen.
 - e. Wipe tables in the dining area.
 - f. Clean up major crumbs from the carpet.
 - g. Rinse the coffee pots and leave them to dry.
 - h. Take home rags to wash.
5. If your ladies have been clearly instructed, you should not need to do a thing besides pop in to thank them for serving.
