

# Church Picnic List

## Logistics

- It's at Chautauqua—outside, not in the pavilion. In case of rain, it will be at the church instead.
- Appoint a group member to go early and “save” the shelter nearest to the pavilion if possible. (Any shelter is fine if it's taken.)
- Haul 2-3 serving tables to the park (can use lightweight, foldable tables from church)
- Move existing picnic tables over to area for seating.
- All church members should bring an item to share and blankets/chairs.

## Meat/Buns

- Order 96 (8 dozen) hamburgers from Valley Meat (should be 2 boxes); pick them up.
- Charge 72 (6 dozen) hot dogs at Leever's; pick them up.
- Order corresponding (14 dozen) buns at Leever's; pick them up.
- Assign a group member to bring condiments.
- Council members will be in charge of bringing grills & grilling. Check in with deacons to make sure the loop is closed on this.

## Items to Haul

- Tablecloths for serving tables (optional)
- Trays & serving utensils for “not grilled” and “grilled” meat.
- Salt and pepper shakers
- Count and transport plates, cups, napkins, and utensils.
- Plan drinks in whatever way you'd like – assign group members to bring lemonade or 2-liters, for example, or mix a big cooler or lemonade or water, etc. Be creative! I do not think that coffee is necessary, but that's up to you.
- Bring lots of serving utensils including tongs
